Read about our collaboration with Franciscan Health and the integrated care for patients utilizing Meridian Behavioral and Psychiatric Health offices in Mooresville and Indianapolis. A new School-Based Health Clinic has *sprouted* in Frankfort, modeled after the work we've started in Muncie, Anderson, Richmond, and Modoc. Besides medical services, these Meridian School-Based Health Clinics offer behavioral health services and give school-aged children easy access to a full range of health services. Even more exciting, is they are open to anyone. Essentially, our school clinics are neighborhood clinics, giving essential health care to families who may not have easy access otherwise.

Be sure to check out how we're *nourishing* our work in mental health wellness and look at all the work we're doing to spotlight our Speaker Series, which brings community stakeholders and statewide policymakers together, focusing on addictions recovery efforts and mental health.

The Meridian family serves over 45,000 patients in nearly half the counties in Indiana. And we're *blooming* even more where we see opportunity to enrich the work, by focusing more on our communities, our expert medical staff, and our collaborative partnerships.

PHYSICAL

Our physical health services help form the strong trunk of our tree, supporting a vast range of primary medical care specialties including family medicine, pediatrics, pharmacy, urgent care, dental, women's health (OB/GYN), and internal medicine. Reaching out to meet the diverse needs of communities throughout Indiana, Meridian continues to grow and expand. Our telehealth services act as vital branches, extending access to care for patients across the state.





MENTAL

Mental wellness and physical well-being are deeply interconnected. Meridian offers a full spectrum of behavioral health services, including psychiatry, counseling, inpatient and outpatient therapy, addiction and recovery programs, children and family programs, and crisis services. Our interwoven approach extends to home and school-based programs, skill-building initiatives, and mental health programs for individuals with intellectual and developmental disorders, ensuring comprehensive support across all facets of care.



SOCIAL

Social health is a vital part of whole-person health and is interdependent with one's environment. Healthier people create healthier communities. Rooted in this belief, the Suzanne Gresham Center and Child Advocacy Center offers school-based services, foster care, adoption services, supported housing programs, and a wide array of children and family programs. These and other Meridian community resources empower individuals to become independent, overcome challenges, and grow. Through these interwoven efforts, we nurture social well-being and strengthen the fabric of our communities.



Growth in Integrated Care

Our growth in integrated care is based in our collaborations with hospital systems and local schools, as well as our commitment to providing enhanced service options in-house for happier, healthier patients.



New Franciscan Health collaboration



Franciscan Health is one of our newest partnerships providing integrated care for patients at our Indianapolis and Mooresville locations. The high-quality behavioral and psychiatric health care that patients have come to count on now includes an even wider spectrum of integrated care specialties for which we are known so well. These new services include primary medical care, point of care testing, and vaccinations. Additional expanded services also are available to help treat and support mothers and babies who are dependent on substances.





Growing convenience of on-site pharmacies

Our focus on creating a medical home and establishing a continuum of care for patients in communities extends into pharmacy services at Meridian Health Rx locations in Muncie, Anderson, and Richmond. By using these on-site pharmacies, patients enjoy improved continuity of care between their healthcare provider and pharmacy, which ensures patients receive safer, more effective medication management. Meridian Health Rx services also include free delivery and copay assistance, improving accessibility, and convenience for our patients. These programs empower patients to be active participants in improving their overall

health through collaboration, reduced errors, and enhanced medication adherence. Meridian Health Rx employs pharmacists and technicians to deliver medication and education to all patients throughout all of our clinics. Meridian Health Rx tele-pharmacy located in Anderson enables our pharmacist in Muncie to connect virtually with our patients daily in Anderson. These in-house pharmacies align with Meridian's integrated healthcare model to increase patient access to care, convenience, cost savings, and overall satisfaction.

School-Based Health Clinics flourishing

Meridian School-Based Health Clinics (SBHC) recently opened at Anderson Preparatory Academy, Jay County Schools, and Frankfort Community Schools. These in-school clinics are among the newest in a growing portfolio that now includes seven clinics throughout the state. Taking care of communities is at the core of our mission, and the School-Based Health Clinics, a collaborative partnership with Meridian and community schools, extends our "whole-person" health philosophy, integrating physical, mental, and social well-being all housed in a health center within or adjacent to the school. They offer a convenient

way for students and their families to access healthcare services that focus on physical, mental, and social well-being. The SBHCs allow us to provide access to preventive care to keep kids well and in school, in turn decreasing absenteeism. The program itself provides comfort to students and decreases barriers for parents and students to receive vital health services. Additionally, we've found this preventative health model supports health care for those in the school systems, including students, their families, and faculty, and staff.



Strengthening Our Roots

The seed of Meridian Health Services was mental health nearly 50 years ago, and this expertise is more important than ever as the nation battles a mental health crisis. Meridian is planting mental and physical health resources throughout the state to help serve more people in more communities.

After Rialzo, Meridian is reaching more people in more places

After 14 years of our signature charity gala, Rialzo, Meridian transitioned away from a fundraising party to a broader system of community care statewide. 2024 gave way to free community events across the state so we could easily spread our message of integrated health care and provide more access to families who need it most. Over the years, funds raised at Rialzo supported addiction recovery, youth mental health services, and school-based health clinics. It was the right platform at the right time. But times change and the nation faces a monumental mental health crisis, particularly among youth. We can help more people in more places as our continuum of care continues to extend to more than 40 counties across Indiana. Our free community-based events like the Back-to-School Fit Fairs, Give Kids a Smile, and Flu-Lapalooza all give greater access to important health services and information, especially to those in traditionally underserved communities.



Filmmaker gives featured Speaker Series talk

Randi Silverman, a national award-winning filmmaker and mother who advocates for youth mental health, was featured in last fall's Community Health Speaker Series. The story of her own child's struggle and her personal anguish, as a mother, was inspiring. She is the founder and former Executive Director of the Youth Mental Health Project, a nonprofit organization that educates, empowers, and supports families and communities to better understand and care for the mental health of youth. A panel of local experts addressed substance use, child trafficking, and mental health resources, following Silverman's remarks. The Speaker Series, launched in 2018, brings together community leaders, professionals, educators, and the public to discuss and identify issues surrounding community health.



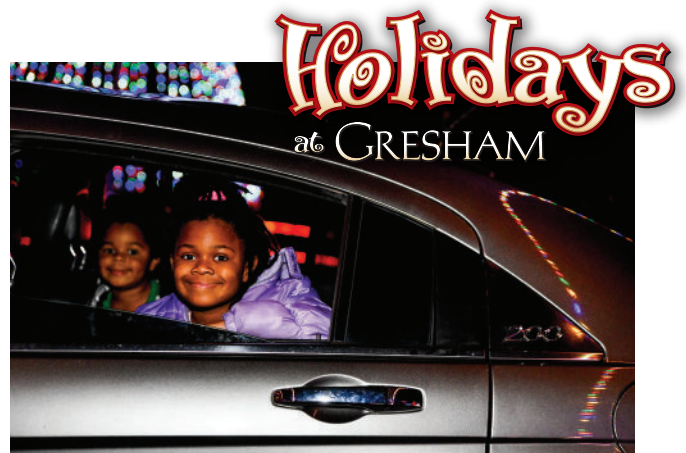
Flourishing Communities

We raised more than \$16,000 – that's 60 percent more than our initial goal – for Hope and Healing Comfort Kits given to children at our Child Advocacy Center who have experienced trauma from abuse, neglect, substance use, or domestic violence. Online donations and a collection from visitors at Holidays at Gresham, Meridian's drive-thru light exhibit in Muncie, helped provide 400 Hope and Healing Comfort Kits, which included a blanket, stuffed animal, and other age-appropriate activity items to help the healing begin.

Community support helps fund pediatric outreach

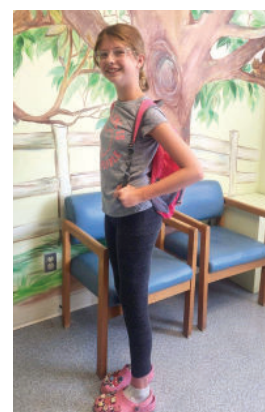

systems in Muncie, Richmond, and Frankfort. This new model still focuses on family yet gives greater impact to many more communities and students, while providing a greater amount of health services for those in need. Easy access to essential integrated medical services for students, their families, as well as teachers and community members, makes our in-school clinics a unique experience. The Back-to-School Fit Fairs give families an opportunity to receive required school health physicals, vaccinations and participate in sports clinics during school registration days.
